Fact Sheet

The Training Source, Inc. is an award-winning Prince George's County, Maryland nonprofit organization with a 27-year history of providing life-changing and results-oriented programs and services to employers and some of Metropolitan Washington's most disadvantaged residents, including individuals who are low-income, unemployed, underemployed, dislocated workers, welfare-to-work transitioners, homeless, physically or intellectually challenged, returning citizens, at-risk youth, etc.

- Comprehensive Employment Training employment training and job placement assistance to assist
 unemployed and underemployed residents to gain the life skills, professional skills and technical skills needed
 to successfully transition to full-time employment earning living wages that allow them to support themselves
 and their families. These 10-week, 300-hour programs run throughout the year and are conducted at our 3,600
 square foot training facility in Seat Pleasant, MD (accessible via the Addison Road Metro). Training focuses on
 office, hospitality and healthcare occupations.
- Youth Leadership Program 3-year program to help 10th-12th grade students develop leadership and mentoring skills, make smart choices, complete high school, and successfully transition to college or careers. The foundation of this program is conducted at our Seat Pleasant site. However, field trips (HBCU East Coast Tour, museums, Embassies, youth conferences, career fairs, etc.) expose them to places and points of interest throughout the region and beyond.
- Professional Skills Training & Job Readiness Training customized life and employability skills training
 programs designed to assist targeted job seekers to successfully secure and retain employment. Populations
 served include healthcare job training students (Health Industry Partnership of Prince George's & Charles
 Counties), summer youth employment programs (Maryland Community Connection, City of Seat Pleasant,
 Prince George's County Office of Human Resources), etc. Training is held at our Seat Pleasant site or at partner
 locations in the county.
- Quick-Start Computer Training training to assist computer literate, unemployed individuals to update their technical skills rapidly to assist them in quickly transitioning back to work with currently in-demand employability skills. These one-day computer classes are conducted at our training facility in Seat Pleasant.
- Community Supportive Services services onsite or in the community to area residents such as information and referrals to other agencies, a professional clothing closet for job seekers, onsite assistance and use of technology to apply for social services (SNAP/food stamps, cash assistance, child care vouchers, medical assistance, etc.), tobacco education, etc.
- **Employer Services** staffing assistance, staff professional and technical training, retreat planning and facilitation, conference plenary and breakout sessions, etc. to promote effective and efficient workplaces. These services are fee-based, with proceeds supporting the fee-free programs above.
