

GOV. HOGAN ISSUES STAY-AT-HOME ORDER EFFECTIVE 8PM TODAY

March 30, 2020

All Marylanders will be under Stay-At-Home orders effective 8PM today and will only be allowed to leave home for **ESSENTIAL NEEDS ONLY!** Anyone who is knowingly and willfully in violation of this Executive Order will be guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction is subject to imprisonment not to exceed one year or a fine not exceeding \$5,000, or both. COVID-19 (Coronavirus)
All **non-essential** Maryland businesses have been ordered to **CLOSE**.

Only essential functions remain open:

- Banks/Insurance Companies
- Food Delivery/Carryout
- Gas Stations
- Medical Care Facilities/Pharmacies
- Grocery Stores
- Law Enforcement/Fire and Rescue
- Veterinarian/Pet Supply Stores
- Utility Providers
